Our team provides evaluation and treatment for patients from birth through 21 years of age with complex, unusual, severe, or persistent infections. Some common conditions we see include the following: HIV/AIDS, HIV exposure, and other immune deficiency states, antibiotic-resistant bacterial infections, latent and active tuberculosis (as well as infections with non-tuberculous mycobacteria), recurrent or persistent fevers, and infections of the lymph nodes. We also provide travel medicine and foreign adoption evaluations. Please be advised that pre-travel appointments should take place at least one month prior to the planned travel. Required travel vaccines may also have to be ordered; thus, two visits may be required.
