Our team specializes in consultative care for patients from 11 years old to 21 years old. We provide female gynecologic evaluation and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STI), polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS), reproductive counseling, contraception, and menstrual problems. Our specialists provide treatment for male STI and genitourinary problems. We also provide care for gay, lesbian, and bisexual teenagers and those questioning their sexuality, however, transgender care is provided by our colleagues in Pediatric Endocrinology. Additionally, we provide services for other acute and chronic conditions, such as puberty and growth disorders, substance abuse, chronic fatigue, weight management and nutritional concern.
