Our team provides evaluation, diagnosis, management and treatment of allergic and immunologic disorders for patients from birth through 21 years old (adult appointments are available for specialized diseases, such as hereditary angioedema (HAE), but must be authorized by a physician). We treat numerous allergic and immunologic conditions, such as asthma, reactive airway disease, recurrent wheeze, eczema, allergic rhinitis, eosinophilic esophagitis, recurrent sinusitis, hives cough, and immunodeficiency/recurrent infection. The following are some of the allergies we treat: environmental, inhalants, food, drug, stinging insects, vaccine and metals.

<p>WHAT</p>	<p>work-up is needed prior to an appointment?</p>	<p>Please provide us with the reason for referral, a list of current medications and medication delivery devices. We also need any relevant office notes, labs, previous skin testing results, immunization records, and any relevant chest and/or sinus x-rays that are not accessible through CHKD's EHR.</p>
<p>WHEN</p>	<p>will my patient be able to obtain an appointment?</p>	<p>There are no immediate appointments available. If your patient's referral is urgent, please do not hesitate to contact the office directly to have them scheduled. <i>Note: Patients should stop oral and intranasal antihistamines ten days before their first visit, if possible, and should allow for up to two hours during their first visit for any necessary testing.</i></p>
<p>WHERE</p>	<p>will my patient be seen?</p>	<p>Allergy and Immunology offices are located at Fort Norfolk Plaza (Norfolk), Harbour View (Suffolk), Oakbrooke (Chesapeake), Oyster Point (Newport News), and Princess Anne (Virginia Beach).</p>
