Consultation and Referral Information



Our team manages patients from birth through 18 years old, however, patients over the age of 18 may be seen in our Adult Congenital Heart Disease Clinic. Fetal echocardiography and counseling is offered in our Prenatal Clinic. The following are among the conditions we treat: congenital heart disease, arrhythmia, syncope, chest pain, cardiomyopathy, pulmonary hypertension and hyperlipidemia. Our comprehensive evaluation and diagnostic testing include the following: EKGs, echocardiograms, exercise testing, Holter monitoring, event recording, prenatal cardiac evaluation, and advanced cardiac imaging, such as CT and MRI scans. Additionally, interventional and electrophysiology studies are performed in the cardiac catheterization lab.

WHAT	work-up is needed prior to an appointment?	Please send us a reason for the referral and any relevant office records. If a patient is being seen for hypertension, they must be seen by Nephrology first. If a patient is being seen for hyperlipidemia, the patient should have fasting labs drawn prior to their appointment.
WHEN	will my patient be able to obtain an appointment?	Your patient's estimated wait time for an appointment is approximately 3 days, but could vary depending on location.
WHERE	will my patient be seen?	Cardiology offices are located at CHKD (Norfolk), Oakbrooke (Chesapeake), Oyster Point (Newport News), Princess Anne (Virginia Beach), Lightfoot (Williamsburg) and Harbour View (Suffolk).
