Our team specializes in providing developmental evaluations for patients from birth through adolescence. Common conditions we treat include the following: developmental delay, speech delay or disorders, motor dyspraxia, cerebral palsy, learning disorders, autism spectrum disorder, anxiety, and intellectual disability. We also provide recommendations to primary care providers for pharmacotherapy for patients with attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder. As part of the diagnostic process, patients may complete assessments by one of our pediatric trained psychologists within our division. Hospital school specialists are part of our evaluation team and can assist with referral to school based services if the child does not yet have an IEP.
