The most common conditions we treat include the following: asthma, recurrent cough or wheeze, cystic fibrosis, bronchopulmonary dysplasia, chronic lung disease, bronchiectasis, respiratory insufficiency, congenital malformations of the lung, pulmonary hemosiderosis, pulmonary hypertension, immotile cilia disease, spine and chest wall disorders, sleep disorders, and dyspnea with exercise.

<p>WHAT</p>	<p>work-up is needed prior to an appointment?</p>	<p>Please provide us with a reason why the patient is being referred to our practice along with their previous immunization record, a list of current medications and medication delivery devices as well as any relevant doctor's notes, labs, and digital copies of chest X-rays, MRIs or CT scans that may not be accessed through CHKD's EHR prior to the appointment. Please have patients bring a digital copy of chest x-rays to their appointment.</p>
